



BEHAVIOUR GUIDELINES

1. Respect for the others: we do not allow lack of respect as well as physical or verbal aggressions, any attitude of bullying to the other children, educators or any other staff member of 'VIVE LA Ñ'.
2. Installations and material: we request to the participants a responsible use of the installations, equipment, own material as well as their mates and facilities material. On the other hand, the boys and girls will participate in keeping a good order and care of their rooms and belongings, as in the care of the materials of the activities.
3. Personal objects: the theft or improper use of the other teen's personal objects is considered a serious fault. It is also forbidden the possession of sharp objects in the camp.
4. Canteen: The menu offered to the teens in the dining-room will not be changed except in cases of allergies or alimentary intolerances, previously notified in the registration form.
5. Use of the spaces: The participants have to stay in the spaces previously authorized by 'Vive la Ñ' responsible team.
6. Schedules and activities: The participants have to take part in all the activities programmed and respect the hours of night rest.
7. Personal hygiene: The participants must comply with the hygiene standards.
8. Exit of the installations without permission: The exit of the area enclosed by our organization without authorization is also considered a serious misconduct, as well as exceed the limits already established by the responsible staff during the excursions out of the camp.
9. Relation with the monitors, coordinators and the direction: The participants will accept the rules established by the organization of 'Vive la Ñ'.
10. the use of mobile phones, as a camera or any other application, after established call hours, will be restricted to the authorization of the coordinators of the camp.

Should the direction consider a participant has made a serious misconduct will be a clear cause to contact with his/her parents or guardians as a matter of urgency.
